No Go Areas ([See No Fishing Zones Map and Upper River Map](#))

Fishing is prohibited in the locations marked as Green Zones on the No Fishing Zones Map or Security Zones on the Upper River Map.

Speed Zones

The maximum speed limit allowed on smooth waters is 40 knots ([See Smooth Waters- Northern Bay Map](#))

40 knots in Pummistone Passage.

4 knots in Spinnaker Sound Marina.

6 knots in all canals.

Event Boundaries

Northern Boundary

- North of the line between Comboyuro Point and the southern most tip of Bribie Island.
- Outside of Caloundra Bar.

Southern Boundary

- No fishing is permitted beyond the boundary that is formed by running a line from the most north/easterly corner of Fisherman Island to the northern tip of Mud Island, and across to the southerly tip of Moreton Island, at the South Passage Bar. Fishing is also not permitted outside of the South Passage.

Reduced Boundaries

- ABT has a duty of care to all anglers and if conditions are deemed to be dangerous by ABT the southern boundary will be reduced to the Bribie Bridge cutting off Moreton Bay. Conditions including wind strength will be assessed by ABT Officials and a decision made and announced to anglers. Note: Conditions may be deemed dangerous although a Strong Wind Warning is not in place.

Brisbane River Region- fishing at the Port of Brisbane ([See Upper River Map](#))

The Port of Brisbane is a busy international port and a declared security area. Therefore fishing in and around port infrastructure is restricted, not only for security reasons but also for your safety.

The following rules apply if you are boating or fishing around the port:

- No fishing within 30 metres of any wharf or ship alongside a wharf.
- No fishing within 30 metres of dredgers and the associated pipelines
- No fishing under the wharves
- No fishing in, or on, the rock seawall
- No anchoring, mooring or attaching a vessel in any way to the rock seawall
- Fishing is permitted in the area directly off the rock seawall, except when a dredger is operating, when the 30-metre rule applies.
- No anchoring in shipping channels

Obey the Port Security vessel instructions

If you are fishing in the Port of Brisbane area you may see a blue Port Security vessel. The crew on this boat are part of extensive security measures around the port, and at times may come alongside or shine a light on your boat to see what you are doing. Please understand that they have to do this to do their job properly, and will at all times be courteous.

If you are given a direction to move, please comply with this request as you have probably strayed into an unsafe or security area of the port operations.
